Information of the technology in your new PGCLL classroom

While you will be teaching in a space that holds 150 students, there will be some changes to the technology available and method of access in your new PGCLL classroom.

Your new classroom in PGCLL features the following technology:

- Local PC connection
- Laptop connection (Bring Your Own Device)
- Bluray player
- Wireless presentation (Crestron Air Media)

Your new classroom in PGCLL does <u>not</u> have the following technology available:

- Document Camera
- Echo360
- Additional wireless handheld microphone
- Additional podium microphone

Getting Started: Using the Black Box

- Approach the "black box" rack in the corner of the room, and you'll see a keyboard, mouse, monitor, and touch panel sitting on top.
- Press the Touch Panel, and enter in your code: "69672" and then press enter
 - Select a video source (Local PC, Laptop, BluRay, Wireless (AirMedia) and your projection screens should come down.
 - Using the touch panel, you can also adjust the volume levels of the microphone and the video sources.
- Open the rack cabinet box by pulling the latch, and you will find the wireless lapel microphone, as well as the batteries.

Local Computer Access

- If you wish to use the local PC, there is a black box in the corner of the room
- Sign into the device using your MacID and MacID Password

Laptop Connection Access (Bring Your Own Device)

- The classroom features a full standard HDMI connection cable in the centre of the room near the instructor table.
- Please bring an adapter to allow your device to work with a standard male HDMI connection
 - These are sold at the Campus Store, just ask a sales associated.
 - We recommend the Star Tech brand of HDMI video adapters.

BluRay Player Access

- Open the "black box" rack and locate the Bluray Player
- Controls for navigating the bluray are on the touch panel.

Wireless presentation (Crestron Air Media Access)

- Install the Crestron Air Media Guest Application for presentation
 - o <u>Windows</u>
 - o <u>OSX</u>
 - o <u>iOS</u>
 - o <u>Android</u>
- Launch the Air Media application on your device
- Enter in the Address (172.*.*.*) for your room
- Enter in the code that is displayed on the screen
- Begin presenting
