

# **Reinstatement Request Form**

#### Instructions

- 1. Complete and save this form to your computer. Digital signatures are accepted.
- 2. Log in to your Mosaic Student Centre. Select 'other academics' and choose Service Requests from the dropdown menu, then 'Create New Request'.
- 3. Pay the \$100 non-refundable reinstatement application fee to your McMaster student account. Your account will be charged accordingly.
- 4. Attach this form and any supporting documents to your service request.
- 5. Return to the Service Request page to monitor updates.

# **Reinstatement Eligibility**

- Must be a student whose last academic review determined they "may not continue at the university" or were "required to withdraw".
  - Former McMaster students who were in good standing when they last attended and who have attended a university since their last attendance must complete an application for admission to an Ontario university (105D) for full-time studies available at www.ouac.on.ca/105.
  - Former McMaster students who voluntarily withdrew from the university more than 5
    years ago or returning students who wish to pursue a second undergraduate degree
    must complete the McMaster University Returning Student Application Form.

## **Required Documentation**

Please submit a letter outlining the following along with your applications:

- Reasons for requesting reinstatement at this time.
- Reasons for previous unsatisfactory academic performance, including any documentation attesting to extenuating circumstances which led to your ineligibility to continue your studies.
- Letters of reference may be submitted but are not required.
- Why you would expect to succeed in the program if reinstatement is granted (including documentation of what has been done to correct the previous problems/barriers).
- Activities since you were last registered at the university, including all academic work and transcript of grades received.

#### **Submission Deadlines**

Fall/Winter session	September entry – June 30
Spring/Summer session	May entry – April 1; June entry – May 15
Nursing	February 1

Please note, the Faculties of Science and Engineering do not consider requests for reinstatement for the Spring/Summer session.
